4. Exploring possible routes for future collaboration and follow-up

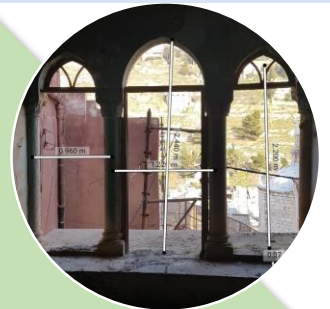
